Summer Courses

We'd like to remind you all about the summer courses that we are going to be running. If you are interested in attending any of the following, please talk to your instructor regarding the suitability of each course and then get in touch with the office staff at LWSC as soon as possible.

3-Day Pony Experience!!

We will be running 2, 3-Day pony experiences during the summer. The first of which will be held from 19th – 21st July and the second from 16th – 18th August. These will be aimed at kids of all levels and will give them the opportunity to interact with other children whilst having lots of fun, riding and learning about how to care for horses.

Simulated Cross Country!!

We will also be running 2 simulated XC clinics. The first will be ran on 24th July and the second on 14th August. Both days will consist of 3 sessions. Session 1 will run from 7:00AM – 8:00AM and will be suitable for riders at **BLUE** level or above. Session 2 will run from 8:30AM – 10:00AM and will be suitable for riders at **BLUE +** level and above. The final session will run from 10:00AM- 11:30AM and will be suitable for riders at **PURPLE** level and above.

Event Training Clinic!!

There are also going to be 2 event training clinics ran here at LWSC, which will include both simulated Cross Country and Show Jumping. The first will be ran on 17th July and the second on 21st August. Each clinic will run from 7AM – 1PM and places are limited.

3-Day Event Clinic!!

There will be a 3-day Event Clinic which will be ran by Deborah Coulson which will run over 3 days. The main focus of the clinic will be Show Jumping & Cross Country. The clinic will include Grid work, simulated XC training and also a session at Beas River, putting all your skills in to practice on the XC course. The clinic is due to run from Wednesday 9th August – Friday 11th August.
